Casinos online cheating in

One of the most common myths among players, especially roulette players, is the benefits of software resetting. At a certain point in the game, players tend to simply reset the casino software, as they believe it will help them avoid disappointing losing streaks in the future

Cheating in casinos online

It is an absolute misconception that the casino software takes into account the results of previous games and builds the subsequent game accordingly. Thus, many players believe that after a certain series, they have to reload the casino client and then it will behave normally. In other words, they believe that the results will be more balanced and they can avoid short-term fluctuations, especially long series of specific phenomena — colour, even-odds, and so on.

However, this is not the case. The RNG works and generates game results in a completely different way. These results are independent of each other. So it doesn't matter what happened before, whether you won or lost, or whether you paused during the game. Of course, it also doesn't matter that these results are preserved in history. There is no reason to believe that the software generates game results based on a player's previous wins or losses in the fastest payout casino Australia.

The reason is simple: in a long-term game, it's not really the playing time that matters, but the number of spins.

So even if you play a few spins a day, win five dollars and close the casino client, it doesn't matter. Sooner or later, the casino will still win.

Casinos simply don't make sense to cheat because they end up making a guaranteed profit. The beauty of this business is the very short-term fluctuations, where there is a significant probability that the player, can win, and quite often does.

Almost all online casinos offer multiplayer games, where multiple players sit at the same table at the same time and place different bets on the same event. Imagine a very realistic situation where players at a roulette table make different bets and cover the entire field. Who should the software be working against in such a case? It doesn't matter, because in the long run, the casino simply stands to gain at least 2.7% of the profits from the bets placed by all players.

Online casinos used to offer quite lucrative bonuses, which even gave rise to a relatively large independent sector — bonus-hunting. This was the systematic abuse of bonuses for profit. There are many players who made good money in those days. It turns out that casinos should have countered the bonus-hunters by manipulating the software and continuing to offer lucrative bonuses. However, nothing of the sort happened; casinos took completely different measures. Most of the sites set conditions for wagering bonuses by increasing the wager and it simply became unprofitable to take them. Today, bonuses only make sense for recreational players who want to play for as long as possible and enjoy the game without wasting their own money.

There are independent organisations such as eCOGRA, iTechLabs, TST and others that regularly perform software testing on the casinos they work with. And, of course, they won't allow the training mode to be skewed. So, if you want to trust the casino you play at, look for games with "fair play" certificates from these organisations. Major casino software providers such as NetEnt, Microgaming, Playtech have such certifications.

Another proof that casinos don't cheat is that bonuses cannot be won back on all games.

Some sites publish monthly payout reports for various games. And there you can see that in some games from time to time casinos end the month in the red zone. Let's say Jacks or Better was a loss-making game for one month. Couldn't they use software manipulation to turn a profit?

If the casino has some sort of bug in the software and the player manages to uncover some of the determinants according to which the results are generated, it will work mainly in the player's favour! The site would only suffer from this — the vulnerability found would allow the player to win money from that casino all the time. Finding such a bug is great luck for the player and a real nightmare for them.

If you think about any casino game then you'll find some crafty individual has found a way to cheat. This can be with inside knowledge, sleight-of-hand, mechanical know-how, or even having an accomplice. Some of these cheats are caught almost instantly, whilst others can enjoy years and years of success. In fact, some are never caught. They only let the world know of their exploits through a book, long after the gambling events.

Of course, we must assume that for every 10 people cheating, there are 8 that we have no knowledge of. Obviously, the best cheaters are those operating under the radar who the casinos are completely oblivious to.

When you imagine a spinning roulette wheel and the tiny ivory ball dropped onto it, you might think it would be almost impossible to cheat. Simply because you could never predict where the ball might land. Well, that's the theory. But in reality, there are several ways to cheat at roulette. These include wheel gaffing, sector targeting, magnetic balls and top-hatting.

For many of the above to function as part of your jackpot winning strategies, you'll need the croupier of the dealer to be part of the plot. The dealer is responsible for oversight for their games table. So it's almost impossible to pull off any sort of cheating without their involvement. The never-sleeping, eye in the sky, is constantly watching the games tables. Both the pit bosses and casino security are looking on. As soon as they detect betting patterns which are unusual, they will focus their attention on both the suspicious gambler and the dealer.

Just as you see in the movies, counting cards is probably the best-known method to cheat in blackjack. Though we must say that we are a little reluctant to call this "cheating." In truth, counting cards isn't as easy as it's made to look in the Hollywood version. You have to be able to keep a running count based on the value of the card first dealt. And then calculate the count for each deck. In the long run, you should be able to figure out the count. Then you have to alter your wagers in order to see a profit. It's a long term strategy that sees small profits for each hand. We hesitate to call it cheating because it's knowledge-based and you're making use of mathematics. As opposed to sleight of hand or any sort of physical manipulation.

Though the game features "bluffing," which, let's face it, is either lying or pretending, it's perfectly acceptable. The more regular ways in which people cheat at jackpot poker are using either peeking or slight of hand. If the dealer is in on the scam, then they will make use of sleight of hand tricks. Thus allowing the player to peek at the cards in the hands of the dealer. Dealers can also make fake deals. They replace an extra card at the top or bottom of the pack for a later advantage. One of the main reasons why slot machines are the most manipulated gaming activity in the whole casino it's the fact that there's no security or supervision around the slot machine gaming floor. There have been a huge number of methods discovered for manipulating these machines. These include such things as using counterfeit money or fake coins (slugs). Before 1999, when a slot machine manufacturers up the security game, it was easy for people to simply tie a coin to their finger, push it into the machine in order to trip the sensor, and then simply pull the coin back out.

On the whole, electronic game machines (EGM) require some sort of electronic work-around in order to make their payout. For this many cheats will use the combined knowledge of mechanics and electronics. For example, they might use a lock decoder to break into the machine. And then make use of an electromagnetic pulse to totally wipe the machine electronics, thereby bypassing any of the machines built-in security measures.

For many of the most famous cheaters, the cheating itself became almost an obsession and they would go back to the casino time and again to perfect their techniques. In fact, it would be fairer to describe that cheating as almost an art form. Some of them, like Monique Laurant and the MIT blackjack team, had movies made based on their exploits.

Monique Laurent probably used the most audacious, and certainly the most technically advanced method of cheating at the time. Along with her brother-in-law and a friend who happened to be a croupier at the local casino, they formed a cheating team. They put together a system whereby the ball was under remote control. Its activation was by a transmitter that was in a packet of cigarettes. Every now and again, the remote control ball would enter the game, and the cheaters were able to take some huge wins from the casinos.

The scheme was known as the "French Cigarette Pack Scandal." What's interesting is that nobody from the casino's security had any idea of the technique being used. The gang was only discovered for the simple reason that Monique was very pretty. She, therefore, bought a great deal of attention to herself. Before long a manager noticed that she never smoked a single cigarette from the cigarette packet she always had with her.

Over 100 years ago the Englishman Joseph Jagger took a trip to Monte Carlo. There he took the casino to the cleaners for \$450,000. Jagger employed six clerks and had them record all the results coming up on the casino's roulette wheel. After analysing these numbers, he saw that one number came up more often than others. This was due to a fault in the roulette wheel which caused it to become unbalanced over time. Such a scam could not work today as casinos check their wheels rigorously on a regular basis.

Once again in Monte Carlo, the Englishman Charles Wells managed to win 23 out of 30 consecutive spins on a roulette wheel. During this session, he was able to win more than \$70,000. In fact, so successful and legendary was his feat, that the songwriter Fred Guilbert of Gilbert and Sullivan, penned a song about the incident in 1892. The famous song was, "The man who broke the bank in Monte Carlo". It was such a popular music hall song that the singer Charles Coburn was said to have sung it over 250,000 times during the course of his career.

In order to beat the roulette wheel, a group of University of California Santa Cruz students built a tiny portable computing machine. The group called themselves the Eudaemons and had calculated that the bets should net them a 144% increase in the possibility of winning. The scheme actually worked and they made around \$10,000. That was until their machine started to overheat. Within minutes it started to belch smoke on a casino floor, before finally igniting in flames.

Probably one of history's most famous groups of cheats were a group of students from the MIT Harvard Business School at Harvard University and also other colleges in Massachusetts. They put together a number of card counting teams in order to beat the casino at the game of blackjack. There was a rather silly movie with the name of "21" which was loosely based on the scams.

Unsurprisingly, the idea of cheating at the casino, with the constant security in such a glamorous situation, has caught the eye of many Hollywood movie producers. You'll find films from Rain Man, to Casino, to Ocean's 11. In many Hollywood movies (apart from Casino...hammer time!), cheating looks glamorous, easy and without any consequences. But in the real world, if you try to cheat the casino, the odds are very much against you. You'll have a greater probability of introducing yourself to the casino security handcuffs than not. Keep in mind that in most casinos, cheating is a Federal crime that will see you behind bars. We suggest that you gamble for entertainment. Don't become so obsessed about making a profit that you would consider cheating at any of the casino jackpot games. It's just not worth it.

Following the recent news of the Heartbleed security bug that led to thousands of internet users' security being compromised, New Jersey's online casinos are taking a closer look at their security software to ensure that cheaters and hackers are kept out.

Casinos in cheating online

In online gambling, hacking and cheating are two separate issues. Cheating can occur similarly to how it's done in physical casinos. Players collude against the house and other players. Additionally, there are newer ways to cheat that involve the use of programs.

Hacking is a different story. Hacking into an online casino involves manipulating its encryption measures to allow oneself access to the valuable information stored within the site. This is frequently done with the aid of software, which embeds into a victim's server and records all keystrokes that occur, allowing its user to gain access to password-protected areas of the victim's site. Hackers usually hack for financial gain, but have also done so for political or purely malicious reasons.

Hacking and cheating have been going on in online casinos since the first online poker sites went live in the early 1990s. This happens with every new piece of technology – almost as soon as a new device or service is available to the public, there's a hacker trying to undermine it.

Sites were hosted offshore and players sent and received money through western union, personal checks, and bank wires. Operating a gambling website in the United States was illegal, which contributed to this risky atmosphere. No gambling websites allowed meant no government protection when something did go wrong.

This led to a proliferation of poker players willing to find ways to cheat. Dishonest players created poker bots, colluded, and data mined their way to easy money. Each of these methods creates an unfair advantage for its user in a unique way.

Data mining is the practice of profiling opponents by analyzing all of their past hands. Hackers who have managed to get into poker sites' past hand archives are able to find and catalog every game that various opponents have played on the site, giving them the data necessary to create graphs that show how each opponent reacts to various poker scenarios and plays his or her hands. Accessing past hands that one has not

participated it in is illegal.

Collusion is a situation where two poker players agree to work together for monetary gain. This can also refer to one player signing into poker sites with multiple accounts on different computers, hiding behind the appearance of unique IP addresses. The player then might dump chips to one of the accounts, creating an unfair leverage against other players.

Poker bots are programs that play on behalf of their users. They can be employed as part of collusion schemes or to simply play while the user is away from his or her computer. Poker bots are banned on most poker websites because they are a type of fraud.

In response to these types of cheating, anti-cheating software was developed for poker sites. It wasn't foolproof, but it helped cut down on cheating significantly. One such program is PitBoss. PitBoss and other anti-cheating programs detect bots' formulaic playing style and suspicious player behavior. It allows alleged bots and cheaters to be flagged for removal and if they're proven to be cheating, banned.

In physical casinos, ceiling-mounted cameras known as "eyes in the sky" monitor player behavior. On some websites, the anti-cheating software is also referred to as the eye in the sky.

With the Heartbleed bug, the concern wasn't cheaters using those old methods. The concern was about all the data that could be easily stolen by attackers. Heartbleed is a weak spot in the OpenSSL encryption software. New Jersey's online casinos rely on SSL to keep their players' information safe.

Hackers have always been a concern for websites that store users' personal information. To log into a New Jersey gambling website, players must enter their social security number and bank account or credit card information along with their personally-identifying information like their name and address. Hacking past a casino website's security can give a thief access to thousands of accounts, worth possibly millions of dollars combined.

SSL, short for Secure Sockets Layer, is a cryptographic protocol that protects valuable information by protecting it through layers of cryptographic primitives. These primitives are algorithms that change simple words, phrases and other types of data into blocks of seemingly random characters. Various types of cryptographic primitives are combined to make up a cryptographic protocol, which is usually strong enough to keep all information stored and transmitted through it secure. Connection between a client and a secure server can only begin once both parties have completed a handshake procedure which is a series of data transmissions between the two that allow for verification of both party's identity.

Once the handshake is complete and a connection is made, a session between the client and the server can begin.

After the Heartbleed bug was exposed, New Jersey gamblers were panicked. Their information was there, vulnerable, ready to be accessed by anybody who could exploit the Heartbleed bug.

But Caesar's, Borgata, 888Poker, PartyPoker, and BetfairPoker were safe. Heartbleed only affected certain versions of SSL, none of which are in use by New Jersey's online casinos. The versions affected are the older versions. These versions have been in use for over two years, allowing information to be easily accessed since 2011. Because online gambling is so new in New Jersey, casinos started their operations with the latest versions of SSL.

This doesn't mean that New Jersey's online casinos are safe forever. They got lucky with the Heartbleed bug – it affected hundreds of servers that store millions of accounts, but theirs were spared because they had recently purchased the SSL software. Say two years from now, a new bug is found and exploited. If a New Jersey gambling site doesn't update its software between now and then, it could be at risk. Heartbleed was a wake-up call for secure websites to always update and patch their software when a new version becomes available.

Casinos online in cheating

None of New Jersey's online casinos have experienced a major hacking or security compromise yet because they are so new. If the IT teams behind Borgata, Betfair and the others want to keep it that way, they have to stay on the cutting edge of anti-hacking technology. You can't get complacent when you have thousands of social security numbers on file. Cheating is one thing to deal with internally, but massive security breaches are another entirely.

This is New Jersey's chance to build up a reputation as the safest gambling option on the web. There will always be hackers working night and day to break the latest software. Casinos need to stay one step ahead of them. It's a cat and mouse game that, if New Jersey's casinos can play it right, can lead to the kind of trust in a notoriously untrusted industry that will bring players back again and again.
