Roulette is one of the oldest casino games around: It is invented during the 18th century in France, and by a famous mathematician named Blaise Pascal.

The famous Monte Carlo casino was the first establishment to offer this "new" casino game, and since it was a "fine" establishment, only the aristocrats of the era knew how to play this game for a long while.

A at roulette casino playing

This is not the case anymore: Anybody can learn how to play roulette game easily and try his chances at an online casino.

The rules for roulette are not hard, but because of the many betting options included, they seem to be complex at first glance.

Well, as always, we are here to help you. In this online roulette guide, we will teach you the roulette online games rules (also available for online roulette in Canada), focus on how to play roulette for beginners, give you lots of play roulette tips and also talk a bit about playing high stakes roulette online.

Take a look at the roulette table before starting to play: This is the best way to play roulette, if you are a complete beginner.

A playing at casino roulette

The table is like a guide to play roulette because it actually contains all the information you need. There is a wheel and lots of numbers on the table, right? The numbers (and other options) on the table represent the outcomes you can place a bet on. In a way, it also contains online casino roulette rules because by looking at it you can understand what options are available for you.

Take another look at the wheel: It contains numbers (between 0 - 37) and those numbers match the ones on the table. Each number on the wheel is a possible outcome, and your goal is to predict that outcome. Let's "simulate" a sample game according to the roulette gaming rules:

• The croupier announces that new bets are accepted. (If you are playing online roulette, there won't be a croupier, of course, you just hit the "spin" button.) • All players place their chips on the table. Chips must be placed on at least one of the outcomes. It is possible to place a bet on multiple outcomes. • The croupier announces that "no more bets are accepted" and spins the roulette wheel. • The ball stops on a random number.

If any of the players placed a bet for that outcome, he/she will be paid according to the paytable.

Sounds simple, right? These steps are also the answer to how do you play roulette in a casino question:

Playing roulette casino at a

There is always a croupier at land-based casinos, but none at online casinos. However, this does not mean that online casino roulette rules are different: On the contrary, the betting options and the gameplay are exactly the same (including winning odds).

So, a single roulette guide winning can be used for both versions – there is no real difference. In an online roulette game, you control the wheel and play alone. In a roulettes casino, however, the croupier controls the wheel and there are other players with you.

This is the only difference: Other than that, online casino roulette rules are exactly the same.

So, what is the complex part? To answer that question, we must take a look at the betting options. Casino Roulette Rules: How To Bet In RouletteNow, there are multiple outcomes you can place a bet on, but they are divided into two categories:

At playing casino roulette a

Roulette inside bets and outside bets. These are references to the physical locations of betting options on the table.

Outside bets are placed at the "outer" sides, and inside bets stay, well... inside. We will explain which one is better in the roulette table tips section, but let's continue with the tables that show both of these options and roulette table rules for now:

You may have noticed that we skipped the "betting on five numbers" option. This is because this option is only available in American roulette. According to the American roulette rules, this betting type is called a "basket" and its payout is 6:1. But if you want to know how to play American Roulette check our updated guide.

None of the American roulette strategies will recommend betting on this option, because your winning chance is only 13.16%. Speaking of which, we don't recommend playing this variant: We will explain the reason below. Now, let's see the outside bets.

Now, according to these roulette game rules, inside bets pay much more – there is no doubt about that. However, they also offer very low winning odds. If you want to learn how to play roulette wheel, you need to know about odds and probabilities too.

Let's continue this roulette guide by answering this question: Which betting options offer the best odds according to roulette guide winning strategy? You can also read our guide about the highest number on roulette wheel and see which are the odds of winning, as well as the potential payouts associated with this bet.

Playing at a casino roulette

Learning how to bet on roulette is simple, you just place your chips onto the table and on top of your outcome choice. Finding which betting options offer the highest winning chances, however, requires reading our roulette strategies that work guide. We have also prepared a dedicated guide to European roulette strategies.

Don't worry, we won't keep you waiting: This guide to playing roulette also includes those chances.

On the table below, you can see the odds/probabilities of all roulette betting options:

Before we continue, we should note that these figures are prepared according to European roulette rules. The odds of American roulette will be significantly lower.

For example, the probability of Red/Black bet in American roulette is 47.36%, instead of 48.64%. You can apply our strategies on how to win at roulette red and black for both.

The basic rules of roulette are simple. And in this roulette how to play guide, we will explain roulette rules in great detail so that you know exactly how to play the game. Still, if you are the type of person that prefers to learn with practical experience, you may want to get started at a real money online roulette casino.

If you want to know how do you play roulette at an online casino, the process is straightforward. All you need to do is choose a trusted casino site and select a roulette game variation that takes your fancy. You can then place different types of roulette bets and get to grips with how the game works.

If you are a novice, we recommend that you start with RNG roulette games. These games allow you to play at your own pace. You can check out the paytable and practice placing different bets on the roulette table layout with no time pressure. On the other hand, live roulette games are better to play once you have a little experience under your belt. The rules of roulette are quite straightforward. In this game, you have a wheel that features red and black slots that have the numbers from 1 to 36 on them, and one or two green zero slots – depending on whether you're playing European single zero roulette or American double-zero roulette. The American Roulette wheel features 0 and 00 pockets. The inclusion of this extra double zero pocket increases the house edge. Except for the wheel, you have a roulette table that features the numbers and several additional sectors on which you can place bets.

After all the participants in the game have placed their bets on the table, the dealer spins the wheel and throws in a small ball. The number of the slot the ball lands in is the winning number. If you have bet on that single number or on a group of numbers that contain it, then you'll get a payout.

According to the type of roulette game you're playing, be it double zero American Roulette games or French Roulette games the lowest house edge, there might be some differences in the roulette table and wheel layouts, but that's nothing to worry about as it doesn't impact in any way the outcome of the game. However, something important to know is the type of bets you can place when playing roulette. Let's take a closer look at them. But before that, we will give you few very useful tips about roulette gameplay.

In roulette, you can place bets on a single number or different groups of numbers. There are many betting combinations all of which bring you different odds for winning and different payouts for winning bets. The more numbers you bet on, the bigger your chances for a win and, therefore, the lower the payouts that the game offers. Other than that, when it comes to knowing how does roulette work, you should know that all roulette bets are divided into three main categories: inside bets, outside bets, and announced bets.

The first two categories are the basic ones offered by all roulette games and that you should definitely know inside out. In contrast, the third is more advanced and featured only in select roulette variants. If you don't feel confident placing bets at first, make sure to claim one of the roulette bonus offers available to UK players. Now let's start with the basic roulette bets, and I'll leave it up to you if you want to continue learning more about the advanced ones.

Once you register at one of the best safe online casinos in the UK, you should learn the roulette rules perfectly to have a great time while playing. If you take a better look at the roulette table layout, you'll notice that the main part consists of the numbers from zero to 36, and the rest are sectors for betting on groups of numbers: odd/even, red/black, 1-18/19-36, a column bet, and dozens.

The bets that you place on the numbers themselves are called inside bets, whereas the bets that you place on the other sectors are called outside bets. The house edge varies across the different types of bets. There are seven types of inside roulette bets, as described and illustrated below:

As you can see, the inside betting combinations are logical and easy to remember, just like most rules of roulette. As we already mentioned, inside bets bring you different chances for a win and different payouts, but if you're playing at legal and fair online roulette sites, then you can leave that up to the software. Also, keep in mind that the house edge of the bets will vary depending on whether you are playing a roulette game with just one zero or with a double zero pocket. We recommend the top roulette sites in India for beginner Indian players.

If you, on the other hand, decide to play at a land-based casino or an online live dealer table, then I would suggest you read up on the subject, as the dealers are humans and as such might make a mistake. For such cases, I advise you to also check out our article on the odds and probabilities that the different roulette bets bring you. That way, you can find the payouts for a corner bet, street bet, and every other type of inside bet.

As we already mentioned, the outside bets in roulette are those bets placed outside the number field, on the sectors that cover the bigger groups of numbers. There are five common types of outside bets:

A roulette playing at casino

There's another bet that is considered to be an outside bet but is available only in certain roulette variations. It's called the snake bet and it covers the red numbers 1, 5, 9, 12, 14, 16, 19, 23, 27, 30, 32 and 34, creating the shape of a snake. In this bet, all the numbers are covered by one chip.

Some games also feature a black snake bet which again resembles a snake but consists only of black numbers: 2, 6, 8, 10, 13, 17, 20, 24, 26, 29, 28, 31 and 35. In the black snake betting combination, the 17/20 numbers and 26/29 are split bets, while all the rest are straights.

Announced roulette bets are special betting combinations most commonly featured in French Roulette though also often present in online European Roulette variants. They are actually part of the rules of roulette which you must know. And since they are most commonly featured on French Roulette, they all have their individual French names. You will need to learn them by heart to learn also how to play roulette.

Let's start with the Voisins du Zéro bet, also known as the Neighbours of Zero. This bet covers the zero and the 7 numbers on each side of the zero – from 22 to 25 on the wheel. This makes for a 15-number bet which is made of 9 chips:

Another bet, just like the Voisins du Zéro and covers quite a lot of numbers, is called Le Tiers Du Cylindre. We know that all these roulette rules, together with foreign names, can be confusing, but they are indeed needed. So... It's located opposite on the wheel compared to the Voisins du Zéro and covers 12 numbers – from 27 to 33 on the wheel.

This is where the name of the bet comes from – it literally translates to One Third of the Wheel. All the numbers covered by this bet are: 27, 13, 36, 11, 30, 8, 23, 10, 5, 24, 16 and 33. This is a 6-piece bet. One chip is placed on the roulette table for each of the following splits: 5/8, 10/11, 13/16, 23/24, 27/30 and 33/36.

Another popular announced bet is called Orphelins. This is pretty much the bet that covers what is not covered by the Voisins du Zéro and the Tier bets combined. This bet covers 8 numbers: 1, 6, 9, 14, 17, 20, 31 and 34. This is a 4-chip bet consisting of one straight on the number 1 and four splits on 6/9, 14/17, 17/20 and 31/34.

Furthermore, there's also the Jeu Zéro bet, also called the Zero Game. This bet covers 3 neighbours of the zero slot on each side of the wheel. It's a 4-piece bet – there's one straight on the number 26 and 3 splits on 0/3, 12/15 and 32/35.

A very common announced bet that you can place on roulette is the neighbours. This is a 5-number bet that covers a certain number and 2 neighbouring numbers on each side. For example, the bet '5 and the neighbours' cover numbers 5, 24, 16, 10 and 23.

To place this bet, you'll need the special racetrack betting section (see the picture above), which is available in most online roulette variations but not in all of them. To know these things, together with the roulette rules, is vital if you want to actually enjoy the game in full and, of course, to win money.

Some online games even allow you to change the number of neighbours you want to cover on each side of the number you've chosen, up to 8. A very useful bet, indeed, especially when you're playing online live roulette and discovered some pattern in the dealer's actions that lead you to believe that the ball will fall in a certain section of the wheel.

Other special roulette bets include the Finals or Finales and the Red/Black splits. The Finals let you bet on what will be the last digit of the winning number. For example, if you bet on Finale 4, you will place a 4-number bet on 4, 14, 24 and 34. This bet is also called Finale Plein so that it differs from the Finale a Cheval, which lets you bet on two potential final digits of the winning number. As far as the Red/Black split bets go, they are exactly what the name says: combinations of all the splits of the same colour that you can find on the table.

Casino playing a at roulette

As in online gambling sites there are no boundaries, there are many interesting and innovative roulette variations that feature even more types of bets. For example, Microgaming's Premier Roulette Diamond Edition features the 'Chip Bomb' bet, allowing you to easily place bets on a certain number and all of the numbers surrounding it on the table layout. Furthermore, most virtual roulette games allow you to create your own betting

patterns and save them in a special tab of the layout for easier access when you later want to repeat them.

We have covered the roulette how to play basics. Yet there are a couple of advanced roulette rules that we still need to explain, namely, la partage and en prison. These rules can be found only in French Roulette games and apply to even money bets. Let's start with an explanation of what is roulette la partage.

La Partage is the most commonly found of the two rules. When the ball lands on zero, players that have placed even money bets receive half of their stake back. This rule significantly reduces the house edge and increases the RTP to 98.65% when the rule is in place.

Some French Roulette games feature the en prison rule instead of la partage. In this case, when the ball lands on the single zero, any bets placed on red or black, high or low, or even odd are not immediately losing bets. Instead, they are locked in place on the table for the next spin. If the bet loses, it is removed from the table. If the bet wins, the player receives a 1:1 payout.

A playing roulette at casino

If you have ever wondered how do you play roulette with the best chances of winning, then choosing French Roulette games featuring these rules is the best advice. These advanced roulette rules reduce the house edge and improve your odds of winning. Remember that the rules apply only to outside bets on red/black, high/low, or even/odd when the winning number is zero. It does not affect a street bet, column bet, corner bet, or other losing bets.

Now that you know about all the possible bets and the basic roulette rules, it's time to try the game for yourself. But how to play roulette... how do you choose which bet to make? Well, it all depends on the roulette strategy that you want to adopt. If you would like to try the classic progressive betting systems Martingale or Fibonacci, then you should pick one of the so-called 'even-money bets' that cover half of the numbers on wheel, when you exclude the zero: odd or even, red or black, 1-18 or 19-36 (high or low).

The strategy you choose will also help you in picking the amount you want to bet. In the same example, you should start from a very low bet to have the room to increase the stake on the next spin after each loss. Speaking of stakes, you should also consider that each roulette game has its own betting limits which differ for the various types of bets. Considering the amount you're willing to spend and the strategy you're about to adopt, you should choose a game with betting limits that fit your need.

Did we help you in understanding what is roulette and how does roulette work? We hope so, yet, additionally, you can check out the following Q&A section about this review of the beginner rules on how to play online roulette. We answered the most frequently asked questions as quick as possible, so they could nicely complement this review of the online roulette rules. Basically, the online roulette rules in the UK include six main steps. Initially, you place your bet (chips) in a specific way on the table and for a specific period of time. Then, the dealer closes the 'betting window' and spins the ball around the wheel, and lastly, the dealer announces and spreads out the chips depending on the winning bets.

Yes, but that's because some roulette games are specially optimised for UK mobile casino apps. Examples include larger buttons, easily accessible settings, 3D visualisations and effects, and a possibility to play with a special mobile casino bonus for table games. Otherwise, the online roulette betting rules are the same for the desktop and mobile version of a UK online casino.

For beginners asking how do you play roulette, we recommend that you check out our simple step by step guide on how to play roulette. Our guide can be used to play roulette online or in a land-based casino. It applies to all classic versions of European Roulette, French Roulette, and American Roulette.

The rules for American and European Roulette are basically the same, except for some characteristics. The roulette table layout is different and American Roulette features a double zero slot. Thus, the total amount of slots on the American Roulette wheel become 38 with the double zero included, causing a slight change in the odds and payouts, and the rules.

Yes, there are roulette how to play rules that you should learn before you play at real money roulette sites. We cover all the essentials you need to know in this guide, including the various types of roulette bets. So, take the time to read this page to get to grips with the rules of roulette.

First, the online roulette rules for the French Roulette game include a visually different table layout (mostly the outside betting field) with the lowest house edge advantage among all other versions (1.35%). Other important rules of roulette that are different include: en prison rule, announced bets like Voisins du Zéro, Finale à Cheval and others.

A correctly used strategy can certainly affect your game but shortly put: no, it cannot change the online roulette rules. A correctly used roulette strategy only changes the odds of winning and, of course, it all depends on how lucky you get with your roulette bets

Yes, there are many types of online roulette that use different or slightly different rules. Examples include high-stakes tables that allow higher limits, as well as Mini Roulette that has a 13-slot wheel. Also, you can find different Russian Roulette rules and simplified roulette rules for dummies. There are also extraordinary cases such as the strip roulette rules.

The 'Neighbours' roulette rules allow you to place bets on entire sections of the wheel. The length of the sections and respectively the number of the neighbouring pockets can be adjusted upon placing your bet. There are three main sections on the wheel to place these announced bets: Les Voisins du Zéro, Les Orphelins and Le Tier du Cylindre.

It is simple since it's based only on luck. Once every player sets their inside or outside bets on the roulette table, the dealer spins the wheel and drops a ball that moves through the different numbered sectors. Once the roulette wheel and the ball stop, players who bet on the number on which the ball lands, win.
